#### APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF A MEMORIAL & INSCRIPTION

## Notes to be read in conjunction with the Cemetery Regulations

(Copies of the Regulations are available free of charge from the Cemetery Registrar at the address shown below)

### **Appointments**

- On a number of occasions in the past, memorials have been installed in the wrong position on grave spaces. In some cases, the memorial has been placed on the wrong grave space.
- No memorial shall be installed or other work carried out unless an appointment has been made for the Cemetery Registrar or other Officer of the Council to be present.
- FAILURE TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT will mean that the Mason 3 concerned will be required to REMOVE or rectify any incorrect installation and no further permits will be issued to that Mason for a period of 6 months.
- A second contravention of this regulation will result in no further permits being issued to the Mason concerned for a period of 12 months.
- 5 A third contravention will lead to the *permanent exclusion* of that Mason from undertaking memorial work in Chigwell Cemetery.

#### **Working Times**

- No memorial work shall be undertaken in the Cemetery outside of the hours 09.00 to 14.00 Monday to Friday.
- 2 No work shall be undertaken in the vicinity of a grave where an interment is taking place.

#### **Dimensions**

- 1 Full details of permitted dimensions/materials are shown in the Regulations. A brief summary of sizes is given below:
- 2 Lawn Cemetery

Headstone: 36" high (including base), 30" wide and 4" thick

Base: 30" wide, 12" deep and 4" thick

Cremated Remains Areas (Plot numbers prefixed CR)

Horizontal plaques only

24" wide, 24" deep and 2" thick. A sloped surface is permitted if the rear thickness does not exceed 4".

Traditional 'Full out' Section

This area has strict minimum as well as maximum requirements. Headstone: between 36" and 54" high (including base/kerb), 4" thick Kerb set: 78" to 84" long, 30" to 36" wide

#### **Temporary** Memorials

Temporary Memorials, comprising a simple wooden cross, or wooden Plaque are only permitted if an application for a Permanent Memorial has been or is being made. A separate permit is required for a temporary memorial and is valid for up to 12 months from the date of interment.
